Article 1 - ORDERS: Orders placed with us shall be binding on us only when the object of a written acceptance from us.

An order shall comprise

 the contract signed by both parties or the order form and acknowledgement of receipt,
 if necessary, specific supplementary terms and conditions and/or special terms and - these general terms and conditions of sale which shall form an integral part of the order.
